Meleagris gallopavo Wild Turkey: Large, plump chickenlike bird with unfeathered head. Seen on ground at forest edges; listen for gobbling.



Coccyzus americanus Yellow-billed Cuckoo: Slender, underside. Often sits concealed in trees.



Circus hudsonius Northern Harrier: Flies low over long-tailed bird. Bold white spots on tail's open fields. Conspicuous white rump, owl- woodpecker with red crest, black-andlike facial disc. Males gray, females brown. white on face. Loud flicker-like call.



Dryocopus pileatus Pileated Woodpecker: Very large



Melanerpes erythrocephalus Red-headed Woodpecker: Savanna-reliant bird. "Flying checkerboard" pattern. Young have gray heads.



Myiarchus crinitus Great Crested Flycatcher: Loud Sedge Wren: Small and secretive. rising "wheep!" call from treetop. Lemon- Buffy flanks, finely streaked back and yellow belly, rusty-brown in wings & tail. crown. Often holds its short tail upright.

Sitta carolinensis White-breasted Nuthatch: Bluegray back, white cheeks/belly, black cap. Call nasal "yank." Hitches down branches.

10 Hylocichla mustelina Eastern Bluebird: Males bright sky- Wood Thrush: Ethereal flute-like blue above, rusty orange on breast. Femalesong carries through woods. Bold spots duskier/grayer. Sits on low, open perches. below, bright cinnamon-brown above.



11 Chondestes grammacus Lark Sparrow: Striking head pattern, streaked brown on back. Long, rounded tail with white corners. Walks on ground.



12 Ammodramus savannarum Grasshopper Sparrow: Soft insect-like song. Buffy/brown bird with orange-yellow mark in front of eye.



13 Pheucticus ludovicianus Rose-breasted Grosbeak: Stocky songbird, large triangular bill. Males have red breast. Females streaked brown.



Passerina cyanea Indigo Bunting: Males brilliant blue Dickcissel: Non-musical song given in sunlight, females drab brown. Often found singing at wooded edges.



15 Spiza americana from top of vegetation. Males have black on throat, yellow breast, rusty shoulders.



Icterus galbula Baltimore Oriole: Males bright orange-and-black, females yellow-orange. Chatter call, loud song heard from treetops.
